97% of students felt that due to the support and facilities of the CUC they are better able to focus on their studies.




"The CUC is a space where I can focus, without the distractions of a busy home life. Without this, it would have been harder to successfully progress through my studies."


All of the above. I think if the ministers of the town got beside the Theological students the experience wouldn't be so isolating and would provide a broader perspective.

Booking system improvment.


Having CUC open after 12am. I'd love to be able to study until 2am, for example.
